MEMORANDUM OPINION

Relator Nissan North America, Inc. has filed a petition for writ of mandamus challenging an August 14, 2014 order of the trial court compelling relator's Director of Dealer Network Development Strategy to answer a question over relator's objection that the answer would require revealing a trade secret.¹
