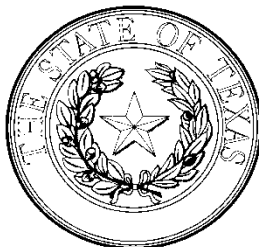

**MEMORANDUM OPINION**

Relator, Leonard D. Faniel, filed a petition for writ of mandamus, asking us to order the respondent, Chris Daniels, Harris County District Clerk, to forward relator's 11.07 writ.<sup>1</sup> TEX. CODE CRIM. PROC. ANN. art. 11.07 (West 2015). By statute, we have no authority to issue a writ of mandamus against a district clerk unless required to enforce our jurisdiction. *See* TEX. GOV'T CODE ANN. § 22.221
