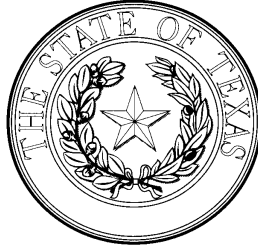

MEMORANDUM OPINION

Appellants, Emjo Investments, Ltd. and H.J. von der Goltz, have failed to timely file a brief. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 38.6(a) (governing time to file brief), 38.8(a) (governing failure of appellant to file brief). After being notified that this appeal was subject to dismissal, appellants did not adequately respond. *See* TEX. R. APP. P.

42.3(b) (allowing involuntary dismissal of case). Accordingly, we dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution for failure to timely file a brief. We dismiss any pending motions as moot.
