MEMORANDUM OPINION

Appellant, William Harris, proceeding *pro se* and incarcerated, has filed a motion to dismiss his appeal. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(a)(1). See id. 9.5(d), (e), 10.1(a)(5), 10.3(a)(2). No other party has filed a notice of appeal and no opinion has issued. *See id.* 42.1(a)(1), (c).

Accordingly, we grant the motion and dismiss the appeal. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(a)(1), 43.2(f). We dismiss any other pending motions as moot.
