## **Original Proceeding on Petition for Writ of Mandamus**

#### **MEMORANDUM OPINION**

Relator, Abner L. Washington, proceeding *pro se* and incarcerated, has filed a petition for writ of mandamus seeking to compel the respondent trial judge to rule on his several *pro se* pre-trial motions filed in the underlying criminal proceeding.<sup>1</sup> Relator has also filed a motion to proceed as indigent and a motion to modify the amount of copies required in this Court.
