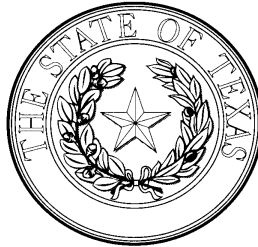

MEMORANDUM OPINION

Miguel Angel Yepez has filed a petition for writ of mandamus challenging the trial court's June 20, 2016 order compelling him to submit to an HIV test under Article 21.31 of the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure.¹
