MEMORANDUM OPINION

This is an attempted appeal from the county court's ruling on an appeal of a justice court judgment seizing ten dogs and two cats. Appellee has filed a motion to dismiss claiming this Court has no jurisdiction over this appeal based on Section

821.025(e) of the Texas Health and Safety Code. *See* TEX. HEALTH & SAFETY CODE § 821.025(e).

Section 821.025(e) provides that the decision by the county court to divest an owner of ownership of an animal under Section 821.023 “is final and may not be further appealed.” *Id.* Thus, appellant may not appeal the county court’s ruling to this Court.

We dismiss the appeal for want of jurisdiction.
