MEMORANDUM OPINION

Appellant, Rema Charles, proceeding pro se, has failed to timely file her appellate brief. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 38.6(a), (d), 38.8(a)(1). In addition, appellant has neither paid the required filing fee nor established indigence for purposes of appellate costs. *See id.* 5, 20.1; *see also* TEX. GOV'T CODE ANN. §§ 51.207,

51.851(b), 51.941(a), 101.041(1) (West 2016); Order, Fees Charged in the Supreme Court, in Civil Cases in the Courts of Appeals, and Before the Judicial Panel on Multi-District Litigation, Misc. Docket No. 15-9158 (Tex. Aug. 28, 2015). After this Court's October 24, 2017 Order directed appellant to pay the filing fee and to file a brief without a reporter's record within thirty days of that Order, appellant failed to timely pay the fee or file her brief. *See id.* 5, 37.3(c)(1), (2), 38.6(a)(1), 38.8(a)(1), 42.3(b), (c).

Accordingly, we dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution for failure to timely pay all required fees and to file a brief. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 5, 38.8(a)(1), 42.3(b), (c).
