MEMORANDUM OPINION

Appellants, TRS Behavioral Care, Inc., Colleen Olfers, Rebecca Buzek, Clayton Goldberg, and Eled Shkurti, representing that they no longer wish to prosecute the appeal, have filed a motion to dismiss the appeal and tax the costs of

the appeal against the party incurring same. TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(a)(1), (d). No other party has filed a notice of appeal, and no opinion has issued. *See id.* 42.1(a)(1), (c). And, although the motion does not include a certificate of conference, more than ten days have passed and no party has responded. *See id.* 10.1(a)(5), 10.3(a).

Accordingly, we grant the motion and dismiss the appeal. *See id.* 42.1(a)(1), 43.2(f). We dismiss all other pending motions as moot.
