**MEMORANDUM OPINION**

Appellant, Jennifer Webb, representing that she and appellee, Benjamin Shapley, “have settled all their disputes,” has filed a “Notice of Non-Suit,” in which she moves to dismiss her appeal. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(a)(1). No other party has filed a notice of appeal, and no opinion has issued. *See id.* 42.1(a), (c). And,

although the motion does not include a certificate of conference, more than ten days have passed and no other party has responded. *See id.* 10.1(a)(5), 10.3(a).

Accordingly, we reinstate the appeal, grant appellant's motion, and dismiss the appeal. *See id.* 42.1(a), 43.2(f). We dismiss any other pending motions as moot.
