MEMORANDUM OPINION

Relator, Cynthia Young a/n/f Patricia Young, has filed a motion to dismiss her petition for a writ of mandamus, stating that she has settled the underlying lawsuit.¹ See TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(a)(1). Although the motion does not contain a certificate of conference, it contains a certificate of service on counsel for the real

party in interest, the motion has been on file with this Court for more than ten days, and no party has responded to the motion. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 10.1(a)(5), 10.3(a)(2). No opinion has issued. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(a)(1), (c).

Accordingly, we grant the motion and dismiss the petition for a writ of mandamus. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(a)(1), 43.2(f).
