MEMORANDUM OPINION

Relator, Renee Jefferson-Smith, has filed a petition for writ of mandamus, seeking to have this Court issue an injunction to prevent the City of Houston from certifying election results and to enjoin certification of a candidate for placement on the ballot in an upcoming runoff election.¹

The underlying case is *Renee Jefferson-Smith v. City of Houston and Harris County, Texas*, cause number 2019-81187, pending in the 270th District Court of Harris County, Texas, the Honorable Dedra Davis presiding.
