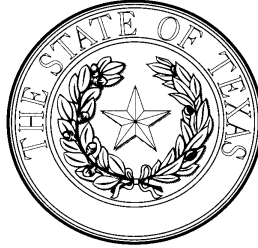

MEMORANDUM OPINION
