#### **MEMORANDUM OPINION**

Appellant, April Small, individually and on behalf of her minor child, E.C., has filed a request with this Court stating that she "desires to withdraw this appeal." We construe appellant's request as a motion to dismiss the appeal. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(a). No other party has filed a notice of appeal, and no opinion has issued.
