MEMORANDUM OPINION

Relator, A.J., has filed a petition for writ of mandamus seeking to compel the trial court to rule on relator’s pending “Motion for Costs.”² The pending motion, filed on June 25, 2020, requests “an order authorizing the production of transcripts,
