MEMORANDUM OPINION

Relator, Nathaniel Jones III, has filed a petition for writ of mandamus to compel the trial court in his two trial court causes to rule on a motion to recuse that relator claims he filed.¹

The underlying cases are *State of Texas v. Nathaniel Jones III*, cause number 1267896B and 1267897B, pending in the 228th District Court of Harris County, Texas, the Honorable Frank Aguilar presiding.

We deny the petition. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 52.8(a) (permitting denial of mandamus when relator fails to establish entitlement to mandamus relief); 52.7(a) (relator must include with petition a record containing documents material to relief sought). Any pending motions are dismissed as moot.
