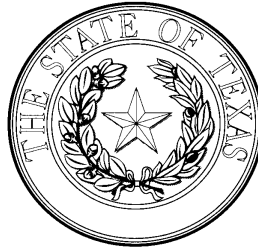

MEMORANDUM OPINION

This appeal was abated based on a suggestion of bankruptcy filed by Transoceanic Projects & Development Co., Inc. The bankruptcy court later issued

an order modifying the automatic stay and remanding the case underlying this appeal to proceed in state court. Appellants have filed an unopposed motion to lift the abatement and dismiss the appeal, averring that the parties have settled their dispute. Appellants further request that we expedite issuing the mandate. The motion is granted. We lift the abatement, dismiss the appeal, and direct the clerk of this Court to issue the mandate immediately. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 18.1(c), 42.1(a)(1). We dismiss any other pending motions as moot.
