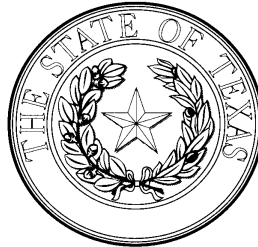

MEMORANDUM OPINION

Appellant, Manjeet S. Wadhwa, has neither paid the required fees nor established indigence for purposes of appellate costs. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 5, 20.1; *see also* TEX. GOV'T CODE §§ 51.207, 51.941(a), 101.041; Fees Charged in the Supreme Court, in Civil Cases in the Courts of Appeals, and Before the Judicial

Panel on Multi-District Litigation, Misc. Docket No. 15-9158 (Tex. Aug. 28, 2015). After being notified that this appeal was subject to dismissal, appellant did not respond. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 5, 42.3(c). Appellee subsequently filed a motion to dismiss the appeal. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.3(c). More than ten days have passed and appellant has not responded to the motion to dismiss. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 10.3(a).

We grant appellee's motion and dismiss the appeal for nonpayment of all required fees. We dismiss any other pending motions as moot.
