MEMORANDUM OPINION

Appellant Anna L. Pitre failed to file a brief. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 38.6(a) (governing time to file brief), 38.8(a) (governing failure of appellant to file brief). On May 26, 2021, this Court issued a notice alerting appellant of her failure and directing her to file a motion requesting an extension of time along with her brief

or a motion to extend time to file a brief within ten days of the notice. The notice informed appellant that failure to proceed as directed could result in dismissal of her appeal for want of prosecution. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.3(b) (allowing involuntary dismissal of case). Appellant did not respond or file a brief.

We dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 38.8(a)(1), 42.3(b). We dismiss any pending motions as moot.
