MEMORANDUM OPINION

Appellant Christian Consultants of Texas, LLC filed a motion asserting it no longer desires to prosecute its appeal and requesting that this Court dismiss the appeal. Although the motion's certificate of conference indicates counsel was unable to confer with one appellee, more than ten days have passed since the

motion's filing and no party filed an opposition. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 10.1(a)(5), 10.3(a). No cross appeal has been filed and no opinion has issued. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(c).

Accordingly, we grant Appellant's motion and dismiss the appeal. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(a)(1), 43.2(f). We dismiss any pending motions as moot.
