MEMORANDUM OPINION

Appellant, D.V., filed a notice of appeal of the trial court's June 23, 2021 final decree for termination. Appellant has filed a motion to dismiss the appeal. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(a)(1). No other party has filed a notice of appeal, and no opinion has issued. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(c). Although the motion does not include a

certificate of conference, more than ten days have passed, and no party has opposed appellant's motion. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 10.1(a)(5), 10.3(a).

Accordingly, we grant the motion and dismiss the appeal. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(a)(1), 43.2(f). We dismiss all other pending motions as moot.
