MEMORANDUM OPINION

Appellants, Brazoria County Alternative Academy and 2D Development,

Docket No. 15-9158 (Tex. Aug. 28, 2015). Further, appellants have not paid or made arrangements to pay the fee for preparing the clerk's record. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 37.3(b).
