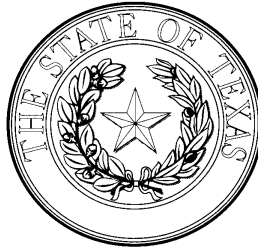

MEMORANDUM OPINION

Relator Roldan A. Villarreal, incarcerated and acting pro se, filed two petitions for writ of mandamus complaining that he “requested the right to a[n]

Exam[in]ing Trial” but the trial court “ignored the Petitions, and Indicted [Relator] . . . [t]herefore violat[ing] his Due Process.”^{1, 2}

We deny both petitions for writ of mandamus.
