MEMORANDUM OPINION

Relator, Robert H. Goode, Jr., filed a petition for writ of mandamus challenging the trial court's July 13, 2020 order appointing a temporary guardian of the estate of his wife, Lockie Goode.¹ Real party in interest, Stephanie McGuire, has filed a motion to dismiss. Relator opposes the motion. No opinion has issued.

We grant the motion of real party in interest and dismiss the petition. *See*
