MEMORANDUM OPINION

The underlying case is a dispute over an insurance claim made by real parties in interest regarding their homeowners insurance policy.¹ Relator, Allstate Texas Lloyds, has filed a petition for writ of mandamus challenging the trial court's May 13, 2021 order (1) denying Allstate's motion to compel real parties in interest to pay

half of the \$1,000 fee for an umpire appointed through the American Arbitration Association and (2) directing the parties to continue with an umpire that real parties in interest assert—and Allstate disputes—was agreed upon by the parties’ appraisers. Allstate further challenges the trial court’s June 29, 2021 order denying Allstate’s motion to reconsider. We deny the petition.
