MEMORANDUM OPINION

Appellant, Angela G. Clough, has filed a “Motion to Dismiss Appeal.” *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(a)(1). No other party has filed a notice of appeal, and no opinion has issued. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(c). Further, although appellant failed
