MEMORANDUM OPINION

Relator, Unity National Bank (“Unity”), has filed a petition for a writ of mandamus asserting that the trial court abused its discretion by failing to “sign[] a written order reflecting its previous ruling granting Unity’s [r]ule 306(a) [m]otion as required by Texas Rule of Appellate Procedure 4.2.”¹ Unity requests that “this Court

order the trial court to sign the proposed order [filed in the trial court] for its [r]ule 306a motion.”

We deny Unity’s petition for writ of mandamus and lift the stay imposed by our November 23, 2021 order. All pending motions are dismissed as moot.
