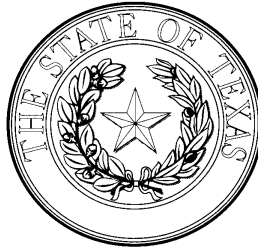

MEMORANDUM OPINION

Appellant, William D. Birchfield, has filed a motion to dismiss his appeal, stating that the parties have reached a settlement agreement resolving their underlying dispute. Although appellant failed to include a certificate of conference with his motion, more than ten days have passed, and appellee, Kendra Birchfield,

has not expressed opposition to appellant's motion. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 10.3(a). No other party has filed a notice of appeal, and no opinion has issued. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(a)(1), (c).

Accordingly, we grant the motion and dismiss the appeal. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(a)(1), 43.2(f). We dismiss any pending motions as moot.
