MEMORANDUM OPINION

Appellants, Richard Moraw, James Perry, Jennifer Mortell, and MacIntyre,

McCulloch & Stanfield, L.L.P., have filed "Motion[s] to Dismiss Appeal Without

Prejudice-Unopposed," asserting this Court lacks jurisdiction over their appeal

from the trial court's January 6, 2022 "[1]etter [r]uling" and requesting that this

Court "dismiss th[e] [a]ppeal." *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(a)(1). No other parties have filed a notice of appeal, and no opinion has issued. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(c). The certificates of conference indicate that appellees, Kathryn Mullen and N. Russell Scott, are unopposed to the motions. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 10.1(a)(5), 10.3(a).

Accordingly, we grant appellants' motions and dismiss the appeal. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(a)(1), 43.2(f). We dismiss all other pending motions as moot.
