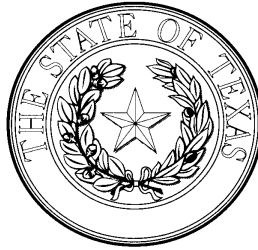

Original Proceeding on Petition for Writ of Mandamus

MEMORANDUM OPINION

Relator Christopher Augustine Gabel filed a petition for writ of mandamus asserting Respondent, the Honorable Sandra Peake, abused her discretion by granting a motion for new trial after a bench trial in the underlying divorce proceeding.^{1, 2}
