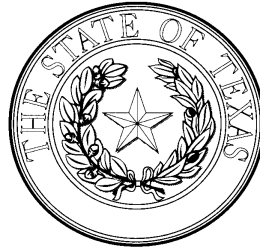

**MEMORANDUM OPINION**

Relator, Serge Gregoire, filed a petition for a writ of mandamus related to his “Petition to Modify the Parent-Child Relationship” filed in the trial court. In the mandamus petition, relator asserts that the trial court abused its discretion by: (1)

dismissing his petition to modify for want of prosecution, (2) denying his motion to reinstate, and (3) failing to hold an oral hearing regarding his motion to reinstate.<sup>1</sup>

We deny relator's petition for writ of mandamus. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 52.8(a).

Any pending motions are dismissed as moot.
