MEMORANDUM OPINION

Relators filed an unopposed motion to dismiss the petition for writ of mandamus because the parties have resolved their dispute.¹ Accordingly, we grant the motion and dismiss the petition for writ of mandamus as moot. *See In re Kellogg Brown & Root, Inc.*, 166 S.W.3d 732, 737 (Tex. 2005) (orig. proceeding)
