#### **MEMORANDUM OPINION**

Appellant Kevin Willett filed an "Unopposed Motion for Voluntary Dismissal" stating that since the filing of his notice of appeal, the "trial court granted in part a motion for new trial thereby causing the order appealed from to be an interlocutory order." Consequently, Appellant argues, this Court lacks jurisdiction over his appeal. *See* TEX. R. APP. P. 42.1(a)(1). The certificate of conference indicates that Appellee Capital Title of Texas, LLC is unopposed to the motion. *See id.* 10.1(a)(5), 10.3(a). No other parties have filed a notice of appeal, and no opinion has issued. *See id.* 42.1(c).

We grant Appellant's motion and dismiss the appeal. *See id.* 42.1(a)(1), 43.2(f). We dismiss all other pending motions as moot.
