**MEMORANDUM OPINION**

Relator W.H. seeks mandamus relief from the “refusal of the 215th [District Court of Harris County] to grant, deny, schedule a hearing upon, or otherwise rule upon” a Motion for Order to Show Cause.<sup>1</sup> He asks this Court to mandamus the Harris County District Clerk or, alternatively, the trial court.
