MEMORANDUM OPINION

Relators, Probir K. Bondyopadhyay and Madhuri Bondyopadhyay, have filed a petition for writ of mandamus, challenging the local administrative court's ruling, which denied their requests to institute a new suit.¹ See TEX. CIV. PRAC. & REM. CODE § 11.102(f).
