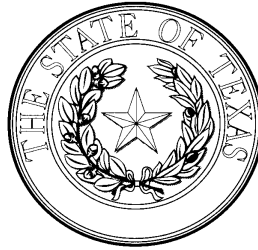

**MEMORANDUM OPINION**
