MEMORANDUM OPINION

On November 30, 2001, pursuant to a plea agreement with the State, Michael Deshoun Kelly was convicted of murder and sentenced to 60 years' imprisonment.¹ On June 30, 2022, Kelly filed a pro se petition for writ of mandamus compelling the trial court to provide Kelly with a copy of the record from the underlying case. We deny the petition. Any pending motions are dismissed as moot.
