## MEMORANDUM OPINION

On March 3, 2010, relator Rapid Settlements, Ltd. filed a petition for writ of mandamus in this court. *See* Tex. Gov't Code Ann. § 22.221 (Vernon 2004); *see also* Tex. R. App. P. 52. In the petition, relator asked this court to compel the Honorable Patricia Hancock, presiding judge of the 113th District Court of Harris County, to set aside her February 22, 2010, order compelling the deposition of relator's corporate representative, compelling the production of documents, and awarding sanctions, entered in trial court cause number 2006-23366A. Relator also filed an emergency motion to stay the trial court's order during the pendency of this proceeding. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 52.10.

Relator has not established that it is entitled to mandamus relief. Accordingly, we

deny relator's petition for writ of mandamus and emergency motion for stay.
