#### MEMORANDUM OPINION

On June 1, 2010, relators, Standard Parking Corporation and S. Michael McColloch, filed a petition for writ of mandamus in this Court. *See* Tex. Gov't Code Ann. §22.221 (Vernon 2004); *see also* Tex. R. App. P. 52. In the petition, relators ask this Court to compel the Honorable Marc Carter, presiding judge of the 228th District Court of Harris County, to set aside his May 6, 2010 order.
