**MEMORANDUM OPINION**

On November 24, 2010, relator Cypress Texas Lloyds filed a petition for writ of mandamus in this court. *See* Tex. Gov't Code Ann. §22.221; *see also* Tex. R. App. P. 52. In the petition, relator asks this court to compel the Honorable Brady Elliot, presiding judge of the 268th District Court of Fort Bend County to vacate his order denying relator's motion to compel appraisal.

On January 18, 2011, the parties filed a joint motion to dismiss the petition for writ of mandamus as moot. Accordingly, the motion is granted and the petition for writ of mandamus is ordered dismissed as moot.
