MEMORANDUM OPINION

On August 28, 2014, relator M-I L.L.C. d/b/a M-I SWACO filed a petition for writ of mandamus in this Court. *See* Tex. Gov't Code Ann. § 22.221; *see also* Tex. R. App. P. 52.
