MEMORANDUM OPINION

On October 1, 2014, relators, Kevan Casey, Jinsun LLC, and Far East Strategies LLC, filed a petition for writ of mandamus in this Court. *See* Tex. Gov't Code Ann. § 22.221; *see also* Tex. R.
