## **MEMORANDUM OPINION**

On April 1, 2015, relators Joiner Bay Estate, LLC, Carl Joiner, and Colene Joiner filed a petition for writ of mandamus in this court. *See* Tex. Gov't Code Ann. § 22.221 (West 2004); *see also* Tex.
