MEMORANDUM OPINION

On April 30, 2015, appellant Grace Instrument Industries, LLC filed a petition for permissive appeal in this court. *See* Tex. Civ. Prac. & Rem. Code Ann. § 51.014 (West 2015); *see also* Tex. R.
