M E M O R A N D U M O P I N I O N

This is an appeal from a judgment signed November 19, 2015. The notice of appeal was filed December 21, 2015. To date, our records show that appellant has not paid the appellate filing fee. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 5 (requiring payment of fees in civil cases unless party is excused by statute or by appellate rules from paying costs). Tex. Gov't Code Ann. § 51.207.

On January 26, 2016, this court ordered appellant to pay the appellate filing fee on or before February 10, 2016, or the appeal would be dismissed. Appellant has not paid the appellate filing fee. Accordingly, the appeal is ordered dismissed. *See* Tex. R. App. P. 42.3(c) (allowing involuntary dismissal of case because appellant has failed to comply with notice from clerk requiring response or other action within specified time).
