MEMORANDUM OPINION

January 4, 2016, relator Elyse Grubb filed a petition for writ of mandamus in this court. *See* Tex. Gov't Code Ann. § 22.221 (West 2004); *see also* Tex. R. App. P. 52. In the petition, relator asks this court to compel the Honorable Barbara Roberts, presiding judge of County Court at Law No. 2 of Galveston County, to set aside her December 30, 2015 order denying relator's motion to strike the
