M E M O R A N D U M O P I N I O N

This is an appeal from a judgment signed September 2, 2016. On November 21, 2017, the parties filed an agreed motion to set aside the trial court's judgment without regard to the merits and remand the case to the trial court for rendition of a judgment in accordance with the parties' settlement agreement. *See Tex. R. App. P. 42.1(a)(2)(B).* The motion is **GRANTED**.
