**M E M O R A N D U M     O P I N I O N**

This appeal is from a judgment signed January 23, 2017. No clerk's record has been filed. The clerk responsible for preparing the record in this appeal informed the court that appellant did not make arrangements to pay for the record.

On May 24, 2017, notification was transmitted to all parties of the court's intention to dismiss the appeal for want of prosecution unless, within fifteen days,
