MEMORANDUM OPINION

On September 14, 2017, Delvin Archie filed an application for writ of habeas corpus asking this court to grant habeas relief reducing the amount of his bail bond. *See* Tex. Gov't Code Ann. § 22.221 (West 2004); *see also* Tex. R. App. P. 52.

Our court has no original jurisdiction to grant a writ of habeas corpus in a criminal law matter. Tex. Gov't Code § 22.221(d); *Ex parte Hawkins*, 885 S.W.2d 586, 588 (Tex. App.—El Paso 1994, orig. proceeding) (per curiam); *In re Spriggs*, No. 07-17-00266-CR, ___ S.W.3d ___, ___, 2017 WL 3399936, at *1 (Tex. App.—Amarillo Aug. 7, 2017, orig. proceeding).

Accordingly, we dismiss Delvin Archie's application for writ of habeas corpus for want of jurisdiction.
