MEMORANDUM OPINION

On August 6, 2020, relator Houston An USA, LLC d/b/a Autonation USA Houston filed a petition for writ of mandamus in this court. *See* Tex. Gov't Code Ann. § 22.221; *see also* Tex. R. App. P. 52.
